

HCP Screening Audiometers from Navy MTFs

Types of audiometers:

Benson Medical CCA-200 and CCA-200mini

Process for the annual calibration of HCP screening audiometers:

- An Electronics Technician, from NMCPHC's Calibration Laboratory, will contact you prior to your audiometers coming due for calibration (Navy MTF HCP customers).
- Loaner audiometers assessment will occur and a timeframe your audiometer calibration will establish.
- Loaner audiometers will be shipped, if needed.
- Send your audiometers to the Calibration Laboratory at NMCPHC during the timeframe agreed upon.
 - Ensure power to the audiometer is off before disconnecting it (and later reconnecting it after calibration).
 - Use the pelican case that contained the loaner audiometers to ship your audiometers to the Calibration Laboratory. A FedEx shipping requisition is provided to pay for shipping to NMCPHC.
 - Include a completed form DD1149 in the shipping case. Ensure that your command's name, mailing address, point of contact, telephone number, and email address are complete and accurate.
 - Navy MTF HCP customers should never send an audiometer in clinical use to NMCPHC without having a loaner from NMCPHC or one of their own spare audiometers to use during the calibration period.
- Upon completion of calibration, your audiometers will be shipped back to you via FedEx.
- Return the loaner audiometers in the pelican case provided.
- Contact the Calibration Laboratory if you have any questions.
