

Interservice Transfers

If you have a patient who is an interservice transfer you must first change the service of the individual to the service they are wanting to TRANSFER TO. To do this you will go to the AERO homepage and locate the 'Tools' tab and locate the 'Edit Patient Info' link. Look the patient up and change their service to the service they are wanting to transfer to and save.

Then you will create the applicant physical (P1A for Pilots and F1A for NFO's) using the service they are wanting to transfer to.

If the member was previously waived for ANY condition an AERO Generated AMS is required to be submitted along with the physical.

All Interservice Transfer Physicals require the following information:

- Current Full Optometry Exam to include both Uncorrected Visual Acuities; for both Near and Far and corrected both Near and Far with manifest refraction (Optometry AHLTA notes of exam uploaded)
- Current NAACA Anthro measurement sheets uploaded
- Current EKG uploaded

Interservice Transfers are submitted with Interservice Transfer clearly identified in the Demographics section of the 2808 and under the notes section explaining what the member is trying to do i.e. "Interservice Transfer to the US Naval Reserves."

For Interservice Transfers- NAMI uses Designated Naval Aviator standards. For SG1 Pilots you can use their original Cyclo performed on their original Applicant PE.
