Master Chief Prince enlisted in the United States Navy on July 15th, 1986 from Milwaukee, WI. Upon completion of recruit training in San Diego, CA, he attended Dental Technician “A” School and Field Medical Service School at Camp Pendleton before transferring to his first duty station at First Dental Battalion, Camp Margarita, CA.

He successfully completed five operational tours of duty with First, Second, and Third Dental Battalions and another at Third Force Service Support Group in Okinawa, Japan. Later, he was hand-selected as the Command Senior Chief for Second Dental Battalion, Camp Lejeune, NC.

In 2006, he deployed to the Persian Gulf in support of the Global War on Terror as the Navy Senior Enlisted Leader of the 24th Marine Expeditionary Unit aboard the USS IWO JIMA (LHD-7) highlighted by his participation in a noncombatant evacuation operation in Lebanon. It was during this deployment that Master Chief Prince became a member of the U.S. Navy Hospital Corps, following the successful merger of the Hospital Corpsman and Dental Technician Ratings.

Master Chief Prince’s other duty stations include: Naval Dental Center, Great Lakes, Illinois; Branch Dental Clinic, Whidbey Island, Washington; and Branch Dental Clinic, Cherry Point, NC. At Headquarters United States Marine Corps, he served as the Command Master Chief for the Medical Officer of the Marine Corps. In 2009, He was selected for the Command Master Chief program and served as the Command Master Chief of Naval Hospital Camp Lejeune, before assuming his current role in October 2011 as Senior Enlisted Leader for the Walter Reed National Military Medical Center, Bethesda and Command Master Chief, Navy Medicine National Capital Area.

Master Chief Prince is a graduate of the Keystone Joint Command Senior Enlisted Leader Course, Command Master Chief/Chief of the Boat Course, and the U.S. Navy Senior Enlisted Academy. He holds a bachelor’s degree in organizational leadership from Chapman University and is an Eagle Scout and Ironman Triathlon World Championship finisher.

Master Chief Prince's personal awards include the Meritorious Service Medal (two awards), Navy and Marine Corps Commendation Medal (six awards) Navy and Marine Corps Achievement Medal (three awards), and several other unit awards.
