

1. The Manual of the Medical Department (MANMED) is issued per United States Navy Regulations article 0105. MANMED concerns matters over which the Chief, Bureau of Medicine and Surgery exercises command, control, and supervision.

2. Designated articles of MANMED establish mandatory regulations that must be adhered to by all Medical Department commands and personnel. Violations of such articles are punishable per the Uniform Code of Military Justice. These mandatory regulations are marked "Regulatory."

3. Articles not designated "Regulatory" are for the guidance of commanding officers, officers in charge, and all other members of the Medical Department.
