Subj: APPLICATION PROCEDURES FOR FISCAL YEAR 2018 NAVY MEDICINE
COMMAND SCREENING BOARD

(c) DOD Instruction 1010.16 of October 10, 2012

1. Purpose. To provide information concerning application procedures for the Fiscal Year (FY) 2018 Navy Medicine command screening board per references (a) through (c).
2. Scope. This notice applies to all Navy Medicine activities and Navy Medicine personnel that desire to be considered for assignment as a commanding officer or executive officer.
3. Background. Command positions are leadership positions defined by Commander, Navy Personnel Command and the Bureau of Medicine and Surgery Council of Corps Chiefs. These positions require special expertise, experience, and a documented career progression that prepares an officer for these responsibilities.
4. Application Process. Officers desiring to be screened by the FY 2018 command screening board must submit an application as outlined in reference (b) no later than 15 June 2017. Previously screened officers that hold the additional qualification designation code 2D1 do not need to submit an application. Incomplete and/or late applications will not be considered by the board.
5. Records Management. Records created as a result of this notice, regardless of media and format, must be managed per SECNAV M-5210.1 of January 2012.
