1. Purpose. To provide implementation guidance for the revised DD Form 2807-1 (MAR 2007), Report of Medical History; DD Form 2807-2 (MAR 2007), Medical Prescreen of Medical History Report, and the DD Form 2808 (OCT 2005), Report of Medical Examination.

2. Cancellation. BUMEDNOTE 6300 of 26 Jul 2001.

3. Background

a. Reference (a) mandated the use of DD Forms 2807-1, 2807-2, and 2808, instead of the SF 88, Report of Medical Examination and SF 93, Report of Medical History. BUMEDNOTE 6300 of 26 Jul 2001 provided implementation guidance.

b. DD Form 2808 does not have an expiration date assigned to it, however it was updated in October 2005 (item 10a and 10b were modified). DD Forms 2807-1 and 2807-2 were updated in March of 2007 to reflect a new expiration date of March 31, 2010. No other changes were made.

4. Action. Effective immediately the revised DD Forms 2807-1 and 2807-2 shall be used for documentation of Medical History and Medical Prescreen of Medical History Report. Previous stock of these items shall be destroyed immediately.

a. Use of DD Form 2808 for the documentation of medical examinations continues without any modification.

5. Exception. Medical examinations for aviation medicine may continue to be documented on the Report of Medical Examination (SF 88) and Report of Medical History (SF 93) until replaced with analogous forms. Only this exception may continue to use the SF 88 and SF 93 to document medical examinations. Previous exceptions for ionizing radiation, radiation health, and undersea medicine were discontinued by the issuance of reference (b).
