1. Purpose. To announce the BUMED Holiday weekend schedule for calendar year 2009.
2. Cancellation. BUMEDNOTE 1050 of 29 Jun 2009.
3. Policy

a. To provide personnel the ability to plan family travel and work schedules, and in recognition of the work performed by BUMED staff personnel, non-essential military personnel will observe the holiday schedule listed below. Functions that normally operate during non-duty hours will continue to do so. Release authority is at the discretion of the code based upon workload and mission requirements, and in compliance with references (a) and (b).

b. Observed holiday weekends encompassing dates not designated by reference (c) as public holidays for federal employees apply to military personnel only.

c. Where workload and mission requirements allow, civilian employees will be offered the opportunity to take annual leave, leave without pay or accrued compensatory time on these days off. This policy is based upon Civil Service Laws and regulations. Contractors will follow the policies/procedures of their parent company.


4. The following holiday weekends for calendar year 2009 will be observed. The holiday, its actual date, and the observed weekend are listed below:
