Subj: REVIEW OF BUMED AND NAVMEDCOM INSTRUCTIONS, SECNAV AND OPNAV INSTRUCTIONS SPONSORED BY BUMED, AND NAVMED PUBLICATIONS

Encl: (1) Instructions and Pubs Annual Review Report - Code Specific

1. **Purpose.** To direct the subject review prescribed by references (a) and (b). Enclosure (1) provides a listing of active instructions and pubs as of 15 December 2007.
2. **Background.** Reference (a) requires instructions (BUMED and NAVMEDCOM) that are 5 years or older to be either revised or cancelled. Instructions dated 1 January 2003 and older met the 5-year anniversary on 1 January 2008. Publication-type directives, inter-service instructions, and instructions which have change transmittals within the last 5 years are exempt from the 5-year requirement. Active BUMED, NAVMEDCOM, and applicable SECNAV and OPNAV directives can be found on their respective Web pages listed in paragraph 4a.
3. **Action.** Executive Assistants (EA), or equivalent, are responsible for coordinating with Secretariat/Directives Branch (M09B31) and completing all code activity required by this review. The codes specified in the "tabs" in enclosure (1) shall complete an instruction/pub disposition plan and forward it to M09B31, Ms. Gail Talley, by 28 April 2008, by memo with enclosure, signed by flag officer/senior officer. Enclosure (1) will be completed and submitted as the code disposition plan. The specified codes shall assess their instructions status as follows and proceed as described:
 - a. Review all of your instructions. If issued after 31 December 2003, they may be reported current if they meet all criteria discussed in this note.
 - b. Revise instructions:
 - (1) Older than 1 January 2003.
 - (2) No longer accurate or the references on which they are based, or they cite, have modified requirements.

(3) Conflicting with or duplicating other instructions, the Manual of the Medical Department (MANMED), or other issuances.

c. NAVMEDCOM instructions cannot be revised. If these instructions are still required, they shall be rewritten as BUMED Instructions. Contact a Directives Branch analyst at (202) 762-3254/3253/3255, or DSN 762-3254/3253/3255 for a new instruction number.

d. Cancel instructions if:

(1) The basic reference(s) was (were) cancelled.

(2) The reference(s) requirement(s) was (were) eliminated.

(3) The directive has served its purpose (program no longer exists).

Note: When a directive cancellation is indicated, the code disposition plan, enclosure (1), shall be annotated and the justification placed in the comment section. The name, rank/grade, position title, code, telephone number, and e-mail address of the program manager/subject matter expert for said instruction shall be included in the comment section.

e. If your code is listed as the sponsor of an instruction or pub that does not belong to you, identify and contact the rightful code sponsor EA to obtain transfer acceptance. This may be accomplished by e-mail. The return acceptance e-mail shall include copy to M09B31 Gail.Talley@med.navy.mil. You will remain responsible for the instruction in question until the transfer notification is received by M09B31.

f. Review your instructions with a view toward combining instructions on like or similar matters.

g. Your assessment for each instruction or pub in enclosure (1) will include one of the following:

(1) An "X" in the appropriate status column (Current, Requires Revision, Cancel).

(2) If the instruction or pub requires revision, provide the revision date (month and year) in the Proposed Revision Date column.

(3) If the instruction or pub is to be cancelled, provide justification in the "Remarks" column such as "served its purpose," or "incorporated into another directive" (give name and number of instruction or publication).

4. Information.
