1. References (a) and (b) provide guidance for implementation of the Overseas Integrated Disability Evaluation (IDES) change. Beginning 30 September 2011, Overseas Medical Treatment Facilities (MTF) will discontinue generating Medical Board cases to submit to the PEB for the determination of Fitness for Duty. Overseas assigned personnel requiring referral into the IDES will be accomplished via Permanent Change of Station to a Continental United States (CONUS) IDES site.

2. For Navy and Marine Corps personnel assigned overseas whose current medical status brings into question their ability to continue full service, the Overseas MTF will submit a Narrative Summary and Non-Medical Assessment from the member's chain of command to the PEB. The Narrative Summary should be documented in Armed Forces Health Longitudinal Technical Application (AHLTA) detailing the medical condition(s) and should contain medical information to substantiate the existence and severity of potential unfitting condition(s) as well as a description of how the physical condition(s) affect the service member's performance of duties. These documents will be submitted to the PEB with an Action Memo (enclosure (1)) to include detailed information regarding the Service member's command points of contact with phone numbers and e-mail addresses. If the PEB finds the member likely to be UNFIT, the PEB will notify Service Headquarters which in turn will issue Permanent Change of Station orders for the Service member to a CONUS site for enrollment into the IDES.
