SUBJECT: Standard Organization Policy

Reference: (a) NAVMED POLICY 06-002 dtd 23 Jan 2006

This memorandum extends the final implementation deadline directed in reference (a), from 30 September 2006 to 01 January 2007. The intent of reference (a) is two-fold: 1) functionally align delivery of healthcare services in Navy Medicine and, 2) establish personnel and financial systems that allow cost-based accounting.

Since release of reference (a), several commands have provided issues for consideration. Commander, Navy Medicine Support Command is addressing concerns and refining format for concise and user friendly guidance. The issues and questions you raised are not substantial in terms of work you have accomplished and progress made for systems migration to Defense Medical Human Resource System internet (DHMRSi). In the interim, please ensure commands continue work reconciling the Expeditionary Medical Program for Augmentation and Readiness Tracking System (EMPARTS) and Standard Personnel Management System (SPMS) information facilitating transition to DHMRSi.
