

Chief White enlisted in the United States Navy on June 11th, 1991. He attended basic training at Recruit Training Command in Great Lakes, Illinois. Upon graduation from boot camp he attended Basic Hospital Corps School in San Diego, California. Right after graduating HM "A" school he attended Pharmacy Technician "C" school graduating with high honors in December of 1992.

His first duty station was Naval Medical Clinic, Pearl Harbor, HI, assigned as a pharmacy technician, where he made Third Class in 1993.

In January 1996, Chief White transferred to Naval Hospital, Millington, TN, assigned as a pharmacy technician. He was promoted to Second Class in June of that year and was selected to be the Assistant Leading Petty Officer for the Pharmacy Department. In 1997, Naval Hospital Millington was disestablished and the Pharmacy Department was relocated to the Navy Exchange.

Following a successful tour, he left the United States for a tour to Naval Hospital, Rota, Spain in 2001. While assigned as Assistant Leading Petty Officer for Pharmacy he was instrumental in the

successful installation and implementation of pharmacy automation for the command; the first pharmacy automation of any kind for any medical clinic in Europe. He was promoted to First Class Petty Officer, December 2002, before transferring back to the United States in May 2003.

In June 2003, Chief White reported for duty at Branch Health Clinic, Naval Air Station, Oceana, Virginia. While assigned, he was selected to attend Command Career Counselor School and become the clinic's Command Career Counselor. Upon receiving his 9588 designation he conducted over 300 Career Developments Boards; leading to 20 C-school selections and five selected for enlisted-to-officer programs. While serving as the Career Counselor he was also selected to be the Ancillary Services Leading Petty Officer for the clinic assisting in the daily operations of four diverse divisions.

In June 2008, he reported for sea duty aboard USS IWO JIMA (LHD 7) as the Leading Petty Officer for the Medical Department. He was promoted to Chief Petty Officer in 2010 following two successful deployments to include the Mediterranean and Operation Continuing Promise 2010. His mentorship and direction led to IWO JIMA's 8th, 9th, and 10th consecutive Green "H" awards and also the ship's first Blue "H" award in 2010. He successfully filled in as the Medical Department's Leading Chief Petty Officer during a six month gapped billet for a billeted Senior Chief. He departed the USS IWO JIMA in May 2011 assuming the duties as Leading Chief Petty Officer, Pharmacy Department, Naval Medical Center, Portsmouth, Virginia, with both his Surface and Air Warfare designations.

September 2013 he reported for duty at Admiral Joel T. Boone Branch Health clinic where he served as Leading Chief Petty Officer for the Administration and Dental Departments and also Tricare Prime Clinic Chesapeake. In March 2014, he was selected as the Senior Enlisted Leader for Admiral Joel T. Boone Branch Health Clinic Triad.

Chief White earned his AA in Business Administration in December 2013 from Strayer University and is continuing his studies to earn his BS in Business Administration with a focus in Health Care Management.

Chief White's personal decorations include the Navy and Marine Corps Commendation Medal with one Gold Star, Navy and Marine Corps Achievement Medal with three Gold Stars and several other mission and unit awards.
