



NEW DOD MATERNITY POLICY



Last month, Secretary of the Navy Ray Mabus announced a new maternity leave policy for active duty women who serve in the Navy and the Marine Corps!

Effective immediately, active duty women will be allowed to utilize up to 18 weeks of maternity leave during the first year of her child's life.

This convalescent/maternity leave includes the 42-day convalescent period currently authorized. The entire 18 weeks does not need to be taken concurrently and can be taken in blocks throughout the first year of the child's life.

This policy is also retroactive for eligible members who gave birth to a child on or after 1 January 2015.
