EDIS stands for Educational and Developmental Intervention Service. These services are provided to children from ages birth to 36 months who may be impaired in their hearing, thinking, seeing, speech, playing, and/or moving differently from other children of the same age. These children could have a developmental delay, disability, or medical condition which may affect their development.

## What Services Do We Offer?

We provide:

- Special Instruction
- Occupational Therapy
- Physical Therapy
- Speech & Language Therapy
- Developmental Screenings & Assessments
- Service Coordination
- Home Visits
- Play-Based Therapy
- Play Group
- Developmental Stimulation
- Parent Training
- Transition Services

## How are Services Initiated?

Anyone who is involved in the child's life and has a concern about the child's development can call the EDIS program to initiate services. Parents, medical professionals and child care providers are welcome to call with concerns over the child's development.

## Questions to Ask About Your Child's Development

- If your child doesn't babble or use words to communicate.
- Does your child have repeated ear infections or other ear problems?
- Does your child seem too stiff or too weak?
- Does your child have different, awkward, or uneven movements?
- Does your child have difficulty reaching for and holding on to objects?
- Do you have questions or concerns about your child's milestones?

## Early Intervention Program

Our goal in the early intervention program is the same as yours: To help families make sure their infants and toddlers receive services now to help them in the future.

Every family with a child age birth to 36 months with a documented developmental delay or who has a diagnosed physical or mental condition which has a high probability of resulting in a developmental delay may be eligible for service by the Early Intervention Program. The law provides that all eligible children receive early intervention services without regard to race, culture, religion, or disability. Services are provided at no cost to families whose children are eligible for Department of Defense Schools (DoDDS) free tuition. Knowing your rights can help you make a difference for your child and for you. All families are guaranteed these rights by law. Stop by the EDIS office to pick up a flyer describing your rights.

## Who is Eligible for Services?

Children who would qualify for DoDDes/DoDEA schools at the age of 3 (36 months) are eligible to receive services. If you are not sure your child qualifies please call us at:
