

HMCS (SW/AW) Gamayon reported as the Medical Design Leading Chief Petty Officer of Navy Expeditionary Medical Support Command (NEMSCOM) in March 2008. Born and raised in the Philippines, Senior Chief Gamayon enlisted in the United States Navy from Subic Bay, Philippines in October 1990. He attended Basic Recruit Training in San Diego, CA. Upon completion, he attended Apprenticeship Training in San Diego, CA where he was meritoriously promoted to Seaman Apprentice and awarded HM "A" school for finishing 1/32 in class.



Senior Chief Gamayon completed HM "A" school in 1991 and was stationed in USNH, Camp Pendleton as a General duty Corpsman from 1991 to 1994. During his tenure, he was advanced to Third Class Petty Officer and selected to attend Advanced Medical Laboratory Technician "C" school in Naval School of Health Sciences, San Diego, CA from 1993-1994 where he finished 2/45 and also advanced to Second Class Petty Officer. He received orders to Naval Medical Center Portsmouth, VA performing duties as a Histology Technician and Advanced Medical laboratory Technician (NEC 8506) from 1995-2000. He was promoted to First Class Petty Officer in 1999. He reported to US Naval Hospital, Okinawa in Camp Lester, Okinawa, Japan from 2000-2005 holding several Leading Petty Officer positions. Upon completion of his overseas tour, he then received orders to the USS Tarawa (LHA-1) as an Advanced Laboratory Technician from 2005-2008. He was promoted to Chief Petty Officer in September 2005 and held key Command collateral positions as well as the Medical Department Leading Chief Petty Officer. He was appointed as the Command DAPA and the Command Financial Specialist. He completed two deployments and earned his Surface and Aviation warfare devices. In 2008, he reported to NEMSCOM and was promoted to Senior Chief Petty Officer. He is currently the Command Senior Enlisted Leader and the Medical Design LCPO.

Senior Chief Gamayon's personal awards include the Navy and Marine Corps Commendation medal (2 awards) and Navy Achievement medal (1 award). His educational achievements include a Bachelor of Science in Medical Technology licensed under the American Society of Clinical Pathologist (1999), Master of Science in Management from Troy State University (2002), and is currently completing his PhD in Business Administration with a concentration in Business Research from TUI University.
