Logistic Specialist Senior Chief Petty Officer Mansfield, a native of Suffern, New York, enlisted as a Hospital Corpsman in 1988. He went to Hospital Corpsman A School and graduated 1<sup>st</sup> in his Class; he then went to Field Medical Service School at Camp Pendleton, California.

His first tour was with 3<sup>rd</sup> Battalion 7<sup>th</sup> Marines, India Company, where he served as a Line Company Corpsman. While assigned to India Company, he deployed for OPERATION DESERT SHIELD and DESERT STORM and was one of the first units to cross the border into Kuwait. While assigned to 3<sup>rd</sup> Battalion 7<sup>th</sup> Marines, he received his Fleet Marine Force warfare designator.

In 1992, he transferred to Naval Medical Clinic Pearl Harbor, Hawaii and was assigned to the Primary Care Clinic as a Member of the Ambulance Crew and Training Team. While at Naval Medical Clinic, he volunteered to go on a deployment on the USS PAUL F. FOSTER (DD 964). In 1995 he was released from the Navy with an Honorable Discharge.

In 2000, he reenlisted in the U. S. Navy as an Aviation Storekeeper and completed Aviation Storekeeper A school. He reported to the Aircraft Carrier, USS THEODORE ROOSEVELT (CVN 71) where he was assigned in the S-6 division as the Repairable Asset Management LPO for 2 years. After his transfer to S-1 Division as the Financial Storekeeper, he received his Enlisted Aviation Warfare Specialist. He then deployed on 19 September 2001 in support of OPERATION ENDURING FREEDOM. During this deployment, the ship set the record for most consecutive days at sea (159) days and was dubbed the Iron Man Cruise. While on COMPTUEX in January 2003, the ship was surged for 5 months to the Sixth Fleet for OPERATION IRAQI FREEDOM.

In 2004, he reported to the Center for Service Support Norfolk as an instructor. He instructed Force Level R-Supply, Unit Level R-Supply, NALCOMIS and also received his Master Training Specialist designator. In 2006, he was selected as a Chief Petty Officer.

In 2007, Chief Petty Officer Mansfield reported to the PRECOM unit GEORGE H.W. BUSH (CVN 77). While on CVN 77, he served as the S1 Financial, QCOSAL and HAZMAT LCPO. During his tenure, he successfully completed his Associates Degree in Administration/Management Studies from Excelsior College.

In 2011, he reported to Navy Expeditionary Medical Support Command and was advanced to Logistic Specialist Senior Chief Petty Officer where he is currently serving as the Command Senior Enlisted Leader.

His personal decorations include the Navy Achievement medal (gold Star in lieu of fifth award) and the Combat Action Ribbon. Senior Chief Mansfield is married with three children.
