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Did you experience an increase in your TRICARE Pharmacy co-payment recently?

Big News: On Feb. 1st, the TRICARE Pharmacy copayment increased for brand-name and non-formulary medications not filled at military hospitals or clinics. However, there is **no increase** for co-payments for generic medications.

Below is a snapshot of the prescription co-pay increase and how it will effect you:

Retail co-payment at Network Pharmacies (30-Day Supply)

- **Formulary generic:** \$5 (no increase)
- **Formulary prescription brand-name medications:** \$17 (increase of \$5)
- **Non-formulary prescription medications:** \$44 (increase of \$19) *unless medical necessity is established*



Note: *If you want to have a 90-day prescription filled using the retail pharmacy you will pay the co-payment for each 30-day supply.*

Home delivery by mail (90-Day Supply)

- **Formulary generic medications:** Free by mail for formulary medications (No increase)
- **90-day prescription brand-name formulary medications:** \$13 (increase of \$4)
- **90-day prescription non-formulary medications:** \$43 (increase of \$18) *unless medical necessity is established*
