Seasonal Flu Vaccination Available

Beginning Wednesday, Oct. 1, 2014, Naval Health Clinic (NHC) Hawaii will offer the seasonal flu vaccination to all DOD beneficiaries (family members, other TRICARE beneficiaries enrolled to NHC Hawaii and DON civilians) who present a valid Common Access Card (CAC) or military identification card on a walk-in basis at the following locations.

- NHC Hawaii enrollees should go to the Makalapa and Kaneohe Bay Branch Health Clinics
- Department of the Navy civilians should go to the Makalapa, Kaneohe Bay and Pearl Harbor Naval Shipyard Branch Health Clinics

Immunizations Clinics hours of operation

Makalapa Clinic (JBPHH)

Mon – Fri, 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.; closed the 1st Thu of the month from 11:45 a.m. to 2 p.m. for training

Kaneohe Bay Clinic (MCB Hawaii)

Mon, Tue, Wed & Fri, 7:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. and 1 p.m. to 3:30 p.m.
1st Thu, 7:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Shipyard Clinic (Headquarters) Influenza Clinic (Bldg 1750) located at 480 Central Avenue (JBPHH)

Mon – Thu, 7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.; Fri 7:30 a.m. to 11 a.m.

To allow time to complete paperwork, beneficiaries are requested to arrive at least 30 minutes prior to closing times listed above.

Seasonal flu vaccinations will also be offered at the exchanges. DoD beneficiaries who present a valid common access card (CAC) or military identification card can receive the flu vaccination at the following locations from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m.:

Hickam BX on Oct. 4

Pearl Harbor NEX on Oct. 10 and 11

~~Kaneohe Bay MCX on Oct. 18~~ (cancelled due to Tropical Storm Ana)

Schofield Barracks PX on Oct. 25

Fort Shafter on Oct. 30

The seasonal flu vaccination is mandatory for active duty personnel

The seasonal flu vaccination is mandatory for active duty personnel and is being coordinated among shore-based commands by NHC Hawaii Preventive Medicine Dept. For active duty personnel who do not receive the flu vaccination during the Shot Exercise, it is available on a walk-in basis at any of the above locations.
