## Seasonal Flu Vaccination Available

Starting Tuesday, 1 October 2013, Naval Health Clinic (NHC) Hawaii will offer the seasonal flu vaccination to all DOD beneficiaries (family members, other TRICARE beneficiaries enrolled to NHC Hawaii and DON civilians) who present a valid Common Access Card (CAC) or military identification card on a walk-in basis at the following locations.

### Immunizations Clinics hours of operation

#### **Makalapa Clinic (JBPHH)**

Mon – Fri, 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.; closed the 1<sup>st</sup> Thu of the month from 11:45 a.m. to 2 p.m. for training

#### **Kaneohe Bay Clinic (MCB Hawaii)**

Mon, Tue, Wed & Fri, 7:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. and 1 p.m. to 3 p.m.  
1<sup>st</sup> Thu, 7:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. and 2 p.m. to 3 p.m.

#### **Shipyard Clinic (Headquarters) Influenza Clinic (Bldg 1750)** located at 480 Central Avenue (JBPHH)

Mon – Fri, 7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

To allow time to complete paperwork, beneficiaries are requested to arrive at least 30 minutes prior to closing times listed above.

### Seasonal flu vaccinations will also be offered at the Exchanges

DOD beneficiaries who present a valid Common Access Card (CAC) or military identification card can receive the flu vaccination.
