

HYSTEOSALPINOGOGRAM (HSG) GUIDANCE

WHAT IS HSG

A Hysterosalpinogogram is an x-ray procedure that evaluates the uterus and the fallopian tubes.

WHAT TO EXPECT

You will be asked to change into a patient gown. An OBGYN provider will insert a special instrument through the vagina and into the cervix. A radiopaque dye will be pushed through the special instrument. X-ray pictures will be taken as the dye passes through the uterus. The dye continues out the ends of the fallopian tubes. This test helps to determine if the uterus is normally shaped and the tubes are open.
