

## **Information Sheet for your Summary of Care**

### **1. Active Duty and Family members with chronic medical conditions, special needs or medical board will need a summary of care from the treating specialist or Primary Care Manager.**

The summary of care will need to include the following:

- a. Patient's name
- b. Age
- c. Diagnosis (if there is a chronic condition)
- d. Required on-going test and consults
- e. Prognosis
  - (1) How the person will do at the PCS location.
  - (2) If the person is expected to make full recovery.
  - (3) If the condition will be ongoing or reoccurring.
- f. Medications
  - (1) If the medications can be substituted.
  - (2) What medications have been tried in the past that did not work?
  - (3) Name of current medication
- g. Treatment Plan
  - (1) Whether the person will need follow-up care and how often.
  - (2) The type of provider needed to provide the care.
    - (a) If a specialist is required, please identify the kind of specialist, i.e. Pulmonary, Cardiologist, etc.
  - (3). Any tests or treatment needed to care for the person.
  - (4) Any durable medical equipment or special requirements need.
