

1. There is an IRS telephone scam to personnel at NAS Lemoore. Someone is claiming to be from the IRS stating that you need to pay back taxes. The caller ID is spoofed says IRS. Please get the word out about this scam.

2. There are numerous people (on Verizon specifically) receiving calls from a 472 area code. These calls are originating from Grenada, and individuals will incur large phone bills if you try and return the call.
3. Please register your car with Pass and ID. Even they are not issuing stickers, all vehicles must be registered. If you previously had a sticker and registered, no action is required. However, if you have bought a new vehicle or transferred to Lemoore from another base, a short visit to Pass and ID is required.
4. Another reminder for the two week notice requirement for unescorted base access for guests. Please get security the request and information required two weeks prior to the requested access date.
5. Safety note for the week: Please slowdown in the Commissary / NEX area. There has been several near incidents due to inattentive driving and excessive speed.
