Greetings from the CO:

As the Commanding Officer of U. S. Naval Hospital Rota I would like to welcome you to Rota, Spain. Our mission is to ensure readiness and promote the health and well-being of those entrusted to us. We are a small community hospital with a 24 hour emergency room and 31 inpatient beds. We have a variety of inpatient and outpatient services which are complemented by rotating specialists and a robust network of local providers.

Our current staff of 368 consists of Active Duty Sailors, Government Service Employees, Local National Employees, Contracted Staff and Red Cross Volunteers.

During a typical month, we will deliver 7 babies, perform 37 operations or procedures, provide 3,567 outpatient medical appointments and 1,012 dental appointments, process 5,320 laboratory studies and fill 3,811 prescriptions. Throughout the year, significant community sponsored events include a multicultural extravaganza, a health fair for all beneficiaries and a health fair specifically for our retired population.

Hospital's history:

In 1956, Building 52 (now demolished) was completed as the first base dispensary in Rota. An inpatient ward was added to the facility in 1965, and in 1967 the dispensary was commissioned as a Naval Hospital. A continued need for space prompted the planning process for a new hospital building that was dedicated on 29 August 1989. The new hospital building expanded the space from 57,000 square feet to 139,000 square feet.
