



EYE CARE PROVIDERS IN THE AREA SURROUNDING NAVSTA ROTA



US Naval Hospital Rota's mission is to ensure readiness and promote the health and well-being of those entrusted to us.

The Hospital is staffed and resourced to care for the area's Active Duty and Active Duty Family Member population. All other Military Health System beneficiaries are cared for on a space available basis.

"Space Available" at military treatment facilities works in a similar manner to the Military Airlift Space Available program for flights on military aircraft.

Priorities for care at the U.S. Naval Hospital, and all military treatment facilities world-wide is as follows:

Priority 1: Active duty

Priority 2: Enrolled AD Family Members

Priority 3: Non-Enrolled Active Duty Family Members & Reservists (Space Available)

Priority 4: Retirees & Retired Family Members (Space Available)

Priority 5: DoD employees, contractors and their families (Space Available/Fee for Service)

The Hospital does not use waiting lists. Placing patients on a "waiting list" is not a safe practice and we have found that patients will remain on a waiting list for great periods of time. This can be very detrimental to their health.

The Hospital only has one optometrist. Demand from Active Duty service members and their families greatly limit the availability for other beneficiaries to obtain an appointment or eye care services. At this time US Naval Hospital Rota does not provide routine optometry services for Retirees or DoD Civilians.

This list was developed to assist Rota's Retiree and DoD Civilian population in locating eye care services in the local community and surrounding areas.

US Naval Hospital Rota does not recommend any specific provider of eye care services and US Naval Hospital Rota did not review, interview or otherwise research the eye care providers on this list other than to verify they were listed as accredited providers of eye care in Spain.

Please Note: Most eye care providers do not speak English. We have indicated on the list if the provider speaks English.
