


## Hampton Roads Virginia INFORMATION



The NMCP Orthopaedic Surgery Department is the busiest Orthopaedic Department in the Navy, serving the largest fleet concentration in the Navy. The typical week consists of two days clinic/ two days surgery. Every Friday the department has an Academic Day, devoted to intramural lectures, Guest Lecturers/ Conferences, M&M Report, Journal Club, and Bioskills Workshops. The success of our training program is evident in the exceptional success of our graduates. Our graduates complete residency training having performed over 1400 surgical cases as either primary or first assist surgeon. Our program maintains 75-80th percentile on the Orthopaedic In-Service Exam as well as have a 100% pass rate for Part I and II of the ABOS exam in over ten years. As a result of

our academic excellence, the ACGME rewarded us with a 5 year accreditation at our last review.

Over the last three years, our department has had over 55 articles published in peer reviewed journals, and over 40 book chapters either published or in press.

If you have an interest in musculoskeletal medicine, and have an academic performance worthy of being considered for a position, we strongly encourage you to consider applying for the Orthopaedics Program at Naval Medical Center Portsmouth.

We currently are approved for 3 PGY positions per year. We have been given a temporary increase to 4. Pending the next site review we hope to permanently increase our compliment to 5 positions per each PGY year(2007). You may or may not be required to complete a GMO tour before starting your PGY II training.
