Course Description:

Inpatient and outpatient exposure to clinical urology under staff supervision. Work directly with staff and residents. Attendance of weekly clinical conferences, Bimonthly pathology conferences and journal club. Observation of urologic Procedures both in the clinic and main operating room. Emphasis on management Of common urologic diseases.

Objectives:

1. To become familiar with the management of urinary tract infections, urinary tract stones, hematuria, voiding dysfunction and scrotal pathology.
2. To become familiar with the management of urologic emergencies.
3. To become familiar with outpatient urologic procedures.
4. To become familiar with reading urologic x-rays including IVU, KUB and VCUG.
5. To become more confident in the physical examination of the perineal anatomy and specifically in the examination of the prostate and scrotum.

Evaluation: 95% clinical, 5% on short presentation given at end.
