



TRAINING COURSE FACT SHEET

STI 101 FOR NON-CLINICIANS

Objective: Increase basic understanding about sexually transmitted infections among non-clinical public health professionals, health educators, health promoters, community leaders, clergy, parents, program volunteers and individuals.

Course Overview: 4-hour course. Students learn:

- Basic information about some common STIs – Chlamydia, Gonorrhea, Syphilis, Genital Herpes, Human Papillomavirus and HIV. Transmission, symptoms, incubation, treatment and prevention for non-clinicians.
- Current epidemiology of selected STIs
- STI Prevention and Control Activities in the DoN
- Effective Behavioral and Structural Interventions for STI prevention

Target Audience: non-clinically credentialed public health professionals, health educators, health promoters, community leaders, clergy, parents, program volunteers and individuals.

Materials/funding to be provided by host command:

Classroom to comfortably accommodate maximum of 40 students. Desktop/tabletop space for each student is desirable. Moveable tables and chairs (vs. auditorium seating) are preferred.

Equipment and Supplies: Computer with DVD drive; external speakers required; projection equipment and screen, newsprint tablet with easel or whiteboard.
