

Defense Occupational and Environmental Health Readiness System- Industrial Hygiene (DOEHRS-IH) Sustainment Training

DOEHRS-IH allows the DoD Military Health System to manage occupational and environmental health risk data and actively track biological, chemical, physical health hazards and engineered nano object process to Service members worldwide. DOEHRS-IH is a web-based application that is used to collect industrial hygiene survey information.

Course Description:

This course is designed to teach students – military and civilian Navy Industrial Hygiene personnel who will be actively entering data into the DOEHRS-IH application - to maneuver and organize data within their Industrial Hygiene Program Office. There is no fee for this course. However, students and their Commands are responsible for their own transportation, lodging, and per diem arrangements and expenses. .

Please note - **Contract personnel** working under the BUMED centralized IH services contract will **no longer** be allowed to attend DOEHRS-IH training provided by the Navy under the DOMA Technologies contract in any capacity.

Skills acquired are to:

Create and maintain IH program office, serviced organization, and location information; manage shop information - shop personnel, processes, equipment, hazards, hazardous materials, and controls; enter personal and area sampling data; create Similar Exposure Groups (SEGs); and perform exposure assessments including statistical SEG assessments.

In order to be eligible to attend:

- Contact the course instructor for a quota (information below)
- Complete the DHA-US001: HIPAA and Privacy Act Training (**JKO**) and Cyber Awareness (**NKO**) training within 12 months of training date
- Complete the DHA-US050: DOEHRS – DoD Industrial Hygiene Exposure Assessment Model (**JKO**) 1Time Course
- Print and bring certificates for Privacy Act, HIPPA, Cyber Awareness, and DOEHRS Navy DoD IH Exposure Assessment Model training with you to class
