NOTICE 2013-01: IMPACT OF SEQUESTRATION ON THE NAVAL RADIOACTIVE
MATERIALS PERMIT PROGRAM

1. The Department of the Navy, like other branches of the government has implemented sequestration per the Budget Control Act of 2011. Sequestration, calls for broad, automatic, across-the-board cuts to most categories of federal spending.
2. During this period of reduced funding and personnel furloughs, commands are expected to maintain their operations in accordance with federal regulations and the approved Naval Radioactive Material Permit. Specifically, each command must ensure the health and safety of personnel, the public, and the environment with respect to the security and safe use of Radioactive Material and ionizing radiation sources.
3. Navy and Marine Corps Public Health Center (NMCPHC) plans to continue normal operations to the maximum extent possible and to continue performing safety and security oversight of all commands.
4. This information notice requires no action or written response on the part of a command.
