Does NAVMED P-5010-9 have the most current field preventive medicine information?

Current section of the NAVMED P-5010-9 include:

- 1) Water Supply
 - 2) Food Service
 - 3) Waste Disposal
 - 4) Prevention of heat injuries
 - 5) Prevention of cold injuries
 - 6) Disease Control
- The pending TriService Food Code will have a field food section, NAVMED P-5010-1
 - Field water supply guidance is covered in NAVMED P-5010-10, Sanitary Control and Surveillance of Field Water Supplies
 - Waste disposal guidance is covered in TM 3-34.56/MCIP 4-11.01, Waste Management for Deployed Forces
 - Prevention of heat and cold injuries is covered in NAVMED P-5010-3, Prevention of Heat and Cold Injuries (Ashore, Afloat, and Ground Forces)
 - Disease Control is covered under DODINST 6490.03. The Armed Forces Reportable Medical Events Guidelines and Case Definitions provides a list of reportable events that may represent an inherent, significant threat to public health and military operations.
