Are your CHCS spool reports out of date? CHCS spool reports can take a while to update. In the meantime, use the DRSi Case Finding module to supplement your efforts. Visit <http://go.usa.gov/cuppk> to learn how to use the module.

Use the DRSi Case Finding Module to supplement your case reporting activities. NMCPHC receives CHCS lab results daily. Every day, these lab results are combed for potential reportable events and fed into DRSi for local use as Case Finding records. If you are concerned that you are missing cases or if you simply need a periodic double check of your current activities, learn how the case finding module can help you.
