NEUROLOGY CLERKSHIP

**LOCATION:** The clinical clerkship will be served in the Neurology Division of the Neurosciences Department, Naval Medical Center, San Diego.

**LENGTH OF TIME:** Four weeks

**TEXTS:** Principles of Neurologic Diagnosis, Montgomery, Wall, Henderson  
Principles of Neurology, Adams and Victor

**GRADING:** Variable according to the needs of the student's Medical school.

**EXPERIENCE:** The student will spend the month working on the Neurology consultation service, performing consultations for both inpatients and outpatients. The student will be under the direct supervision of a staff Neurologist during this time. The student will see on round all patients seen by Neurology, in addition to the ones for whom he or she has been the first consultant. The student will spend one half day per week working in a dedicated headache clinic under the direct supervision of a staff Neurologist. The student will receive didactic instruction in the neurological examination, and didactic instruction in the neurological localization and differential diagnosis. Students will have the opportunity to observe EMG and nerve conduction studies, evoked potential studies, and EEG's. Most students will have an opportunity to perform lumbar punctures in the outpatient department.
