DESCRIPTION: This is a formal, two-year paid internship with the Department of Navy. The selected will be involved in the implementation of the training curriculum; the documentation of the trainee performance; resolution of administrative problems which may arise related to the Health Profession Scholarship Program, Uniformed Services University of Health Sciences and civilian medical students, intern/residency training programs and assisting the Program Director in the development of faculty and administrative staffing plans.

The selected will ensure that the student clerkship/intern/residency training programs are compliant with all institutional and Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical Education, Bureau of Medicine and Surgery and Naval Medical Manpower Professional Training and Education Command by analyzing program content and assisting in developing both short and long-term plans.
