1. The Naval Medical Center San Diego (NMCS D) and all supporting tenants and contractors are committed to operating in an environmentally responsible manner as directed in references (a) through (c). NMCS D is dedicated to protecting the environment and ensuring compliance with environmental standards. All NMCS D employees, service providers and contractors are expected to follow this environmental policy and to report environmental concerns to management.

2. NMCS D will operate in a manner to:

a. Minimize waste, prevent spills and other pollution, and dispose of waste responsibly.

b. Conserve and protect natural and cultural resources.

c. Reuse, recycle, and procure recycled materials, where practical.

d. Responsibly use energy through conservation, efficiency, and use renewable energy sources, where feasible.

e. Be an environmentally responsible neighbor.

f. Periodically review, measure, evaluate and improve its environmental management system and performance.

g. Comply with relevant and applicable Federal, State, and local statutes and regulations, and Department of Defense directives.

h. Make Environmental Policy available to the public and strongly encourage feedback. All military, civilian, and contractor personnel are urged to come forth with suggestions to further minimize reliance on hazardous materials and reduce waste in their own area and in any other area about which they may have ideas.
