Routine Well Child Visits and Immunization Schedule



BIRTH	Hepatitis B vaccine
2-3 days of age	Health Supervision visit #1, weight check, lactation support
2 WEEKS	Health Supervision visit #2, weight check, lactation support, newborn screen results
2 MONTHS	Well Child Visit, immunizations (Pediatrix#1, Hib#1, PCV 13 #1, RV#1)
4 MONTHS	Well Child Visit, immunizations (Pediatrix#2, Hib#2, PCV 12 #2, RV#2)
6 MONTHS	Well Child Visit, immunizations, (Pediatrix#3, PCV 13 #3, RV#3, **Influenza #1 during flu season, must be at least 6 mos, 2 nd dose in 1 mo)
9 MONTHS	Well Child Visit, Developmental screen, Vision screen, Anemia check
12 MONTHS	Well Child Visit, Anemia check (if not done at 9 mos), immunizations, (MMR#1, Varivax#1, Hep A#1, Hib#3 and PCV13 #4)
15 MONTHS	Well Child Visit, Developmental screen, immunization update
18 MONTHS	Well Child Visit, Developmental and Vision screen, immi's, (DTaP#4, Hep A#2)
2 YEARS	Well Child Visit, Developmental Screen, Vision Screen
2 ½ YEARS	Well Child Visit, Developmental Screen, Vision Screen
4-6 YEARS	Yearly Well Child visit/School physical, vision screen, immi's, (Pro-Quad: MMR & Varicella*; Kinrix: dTap & Polio*; PCV13 if needed). * = one injection per combo vaccine
6-11 YEARS	Yearly Well Child Visit/School PE/Sports PE as needed, immunization update as needed (9-11 years universal non fasting lipid screening). Vision
11-12 YEARS	Yearly Well Child Visit, immunizations, (Tdap, MCV4 #1, HPV#1 – 2 nd dose in 1-2 mos, 3 rd dose 6 mos after first dose). Vision
12-18 YEARS	Physical Exam as needed, immunizations (complete HPV series, MCV4 #2@ 16 years of age, assure that Tdap is up to date). Vision.

****6 MONTHS to 18 YEARS of age - Flu vaccine in season**

Immunization Key

Pediatrix – DtaP, Hep B, IPV (inactivated polio) vaccine
 Hib – Haemophilus Influenzae type B (Hib conjugate)
 PCV 13 – Prevnar 13, (pneumococcal conjugate vaccine)
 Kinrix – DtaP#5 with IPV (inactivated polio) vaccine
 MMRV – Measles, mumps, rubella, varicella (chickenpox) vaccine
 Tdap – Tetanus, diphtheria and pertussis vaccine (adolescent preparation)

DTaP – Diphtheria, Tetanus and Pertussis vaccine
 MCV4 – Meningococcal meningitis vaccine
 HPV – Human Papilloma Virus vaccine
 RV – Rotavirus vaccine
 MMR – Measles, mumps, rubella vaccine
 Varivax – Varicella (chickenpox) vaccine
