

# How to Apply

All appointments for civilian PGY-1 trainees are obtained through the National Resident Matching Program. To submit an application to the Naval Medical Center San Diego (NMCS D) program, please use the Electronic Residency Application Service (ERAS) via their website.

For the match, NMCS D anticipates offering four, 1-year preliminary positions. Our NRMP Hospital Code number for categorical is 1403140C0 and preliminary is 140314P0. All applicants must be graduates of medical schools accredited by the Liaison Committee on Medical Education (LCME) or by the American Osteopathic Association (AOA). Applicants are required to be a graduate from an accredited U.S. medical school and must be a U.S. citizen.

## Application Requirements include:

1. ERAS Common Application Form and Personal Statement.
2. Medical school transcripts.
3. Medical school Dean's letter.
4. USMLE Step 1 and Step 2 transcripts.
5. A minimum of three letters of recommendation in support of the application.

## Interviews

Interviews are by invitation only and will be scheduled on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays from January to early February each year. ## Program Highlights

### Accreditation

The Internal Medicine residency at Naval Medical Center San Diego (NMCSD) has been accredited and operating since December 1, 1958. On May 18, 2012, NMCSD was granted a ten year accreditation to train up to 44 residents in Internal Medicine.

### Location

Naval Medical Center San Diego is located in downtown San Diego just minutes away from the world famous San Diego Zoo and Balboa Park.

## Institutional Highlights

Naval Medical Center San Diego is a tertiary referral center providing care for more than 250,000 active duty, retired military, and family members in San Diego County, as well as patients referred from the entire Pacific Rim. Our patients are multiethnic, ranging in age from young adults to centenarians.
