

NAVMEDEAST INSTRUCTION 5100.12A

Subj: TRAFFIC SAFETY PROGRAM

Ref: (a) OPNAVINST 5100.12H, Chapter 1
(b) NAVMEDCENPTSVAINST 5100.8B

1. Purpose. To provide policy and guidance for the Navy Medicine East (NME) Traffic Safety Program.
2. Cancellation. NAVMEDEASTINST 5100.12
3. Background. Reference (a) requires each Naval activity to establish a Traffic Safety Program. Reference (b) defines the traffic law enforcement procedures for the Naval Medical Center (NMC), Portsmouth campus.
3. Scope and Effect. NME will follow the guidance and directives of references (a) and (b).
4. Responsibility. The NME Safety Manager is responsible for the Traffic Safety Program management. The Safety Manager will ensure that periodic traffic safety training is provided through periodic e-mail announcements, display of traffic safety posters, and other means of information dissemination as appropriate. The Safety Manager will represent the NME on the NMC, Portsmouth Traffic Safety Council.
5. Action. All NME personnel will follow the guidance and directives of reference (a) when operating government or private motor vehicles on government property or in a Temporary Additional Duty status.
