

“TRICARE Overseas Program - TOP”

Navy MTFs in the Eurasia-Africa and Latin America/Canada regions fall under the AOR of NAVMED East. These include:

- U.S. Naval Hospital Rota (Spain)
- U.S. Naval Hospital Naples (Italy)
- U.S. Naval Hospital Sigonella (Italy)
 - NBHC Bahrain
 - NBHC Souda Bay (Greece)
- U.S. Naval Hospital Guantanamo Bay (Cuba)

The TOP contract provides healthcare support services to the MTFs in locations outside the 50 United States and the District of Columbia. It was created to provide a similar level of support to that provided in CONUS by MCSCs. The contract includes:

- Claims processing for TRICARE beneficiaries residing in locations outside the 50 United States and the District of Columbia regardless of where the care is received
- Claims processing for MTF-referred supplemental health care
- ADSM dental care in remote locations outside the 50 United States and District of Columbia, not including U.S. territories
- Enrollment and beneficiary education
- Significant change from previous way of coordinating healthcare overseas
- Contract focus is on TOP Prime and TOP Prime Remote enrollees
- Health care finder services and claims processing provided for other categories of TRICARE beneficiaries
- Start of healthcare delivery - 01 September 2010
