### NMETC HQ

Navy Medicine Education and Training Command Headquarters is the single point of accountability for formal education and training services within Navy Medicine. The headquarters staff provide program management; curriculum design and management; academic oversight and accreditation; and serve as the "on ramp" for new programs and requirements.



### NMTSC

The Navy Medicine Training Support Center is Navy's component command, providing administrative and operational control over Navy Medicine staff and students assigned to the tri-service Medical Education & Training Campus (METC) and San Antonio-area medical education programs.

### NMOTC

The Navy Medicine Operational Training Center is a Chief of Naval Operations designated Warfare Center of Excellence. NMOTC provides professional, technical and consultative training services in operationally related Fleet and Fleet Marine Force medical matters. NMOTC has six detachments and 60 facilities at 15 locations across the country.



### NMPDC

The Navy Medicine Professional Development Center is the hub for Navy Medicine's professional development training and education mission. NMPDC has collaborative relationships with more than 100 military and civilian activities, and trains approximately 3,000 personnel from the federal uniformed services, civilian employees, and allied foreign military members annually.
