RMKS/1. THE U.S. JOINT FORCES COMMAND (USJFCOM) COMMAND SURGEON IS PLEASED TO ANNOUNCE THE SIXTEENTH ANNUAL JOINT TASK FORCE (JTF) SENIOR MEDICAL LEADER SEMINAR TO BE HELD AT USJFCOM'S JOINT WARFIGHTING CENTER IN SUFFOLK, VA FROM 09-13 AUGUST 2010.

2. THE SEMINAR IS DESIGNED TO ENHANCE PREPARATION OF SENIOR MEDICAL, DENTAL, MEDICAL SERVICE, BIOMEDICAL SCIENCES, AND NURSE CORPS OFFICERS (O5/O6) FROM ALL SERVICES THAT HAVE THE POTENTIAL TO SERVE IN A LEADERSHIP ROLE WITHIN A JTF/CJTF SURGEON'S OFFICE IN A JOINT AND OR COMBINED OPERATIONAL ENVIRONMENT. DRAFT AGENDA LOCATED IN #6 BELOW. USJFCOM EXPECTS THE SEMINAR TO BE GRANTED CONTINUING MEDICAL EDUCATION (CME) CREDITS.

3. SEATS ARE LIMITED FOR THIS SEMINAR AND ARE NOT CONTROLLED BY USJFCOM. RECOMMENDED PRE-COURSE WORK: JOINT OPERATIONS MEDICAL MANAGERS COURSE (JOMMC) SPONSORED BY THE DEFENSE MEDICAL READINESS TRAINING INSTITUTE (DMRTI) OR JOINT MEDICAL PLANNERS' COURSE SPONSORED BY THE JOINT STAFF SURGEON.

4. COMMANDING OFFICERS: ENDORSEMENTS SHOULD BE BASED ON THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA: HIGH PROBABILITY OF BEING NOMINATED AS A JTF SURGEON OR JTF SENIOR MEDICAL LEADER/STAFF MEMBER; THOSE WHO ARE CURRENTLY BILLETED TO SERVICE SPECIFIC HEADQUARTERS, GEOGRAPHIC COMBATANT COMMANDS, JTF SENIOR MEDICAL LEADERS OR THEATER OPERATIONAL ASSIGNMENTS.

5. CENTRAL FUNDING HAS BEEN APPROVED FOR NAVY AND AIR FORCE ATTENDEES. ALL OTHERS ATTENDEES ARE TO BE FUNDED BY THEIR RESPECTIVE UNITS/ORGANIZATIONS. SEE #7 BELOW FOR APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS. ONCE APPROVED APPLICANTS WILL RECEIVE REGISTRATION AND BILLETING INFORMATION, UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS AND ANY READ AHEAD MATERIALS.
