
b. The board shall proceed in accordance with all guidance in this letter and the FY-15 Administrative Selection Board Precept, reference (a).

Subj: FY-15 NURSE CORPS MEDICAL ENLISTED COMMISSIONING  
PROGRAM (MECP) SELECTION BOARD QUOTA LETTER

Ref: (a) OPNAVINST 1120.8A  
(b) OPNAVINST 1420.1B

1. In accordance with reference (a), this memorandum establishes quotas for the FY-15 Medical Enlisted Commissioning Program (MECP) Selection Board:

Primary Selects: Not to exceed 55  
Alternates: Up to a maximum of 5 in ranked order

2. Primary selectees are to enroll as full-time students prior to 30 September 2015 and complete their education requirements for a baccalaureate degree in nursing within 36 months of enrollment. Alternates will be ranked in descending order and will become eligible in that order if primary selectees decline to accept the program. Alternates can also be used when primary selectees become otherwise ineligible or a student currently in the program is dropped prior to 30 September 2015.

3. Selectees must meet all qualifications for the program as defined under reference (b) and the annual MECP NAVADMIN.
