1. **Date and Location**

a. This administrative selection board, consisting of you as president and the members listed in enclosure (1), is ordered to convene at Navy Personnel Command, Millington, TN, at 0800, 20 November 2014, or as soon as practicable thereafter.

The board shall consider carefully, without prejudice or partiality, the record of every eligible applicant. The records and names of all eligible applicants, determined as of the date the board convenes, will be furnished to the board.

3. **Board Authorized Selections.** The total number of candidates that may be recommended in each category is listed in enclosure (2). The candidates will begin training in FY15.

PROGRAM SELECTION BOARD QUOTA LETTER

1. Per reference (a), the following selection goals are provided in support of the FY-15 Medical Service Corps (MSC) In-Service Procurement Program (IPP):

a. Health Care Administration (HCA). For FY-15 commissioning, includes applicants with a completed qualifying degree and those who will complete a qualifying degree by June 2015.

Primary Selects: Not to exceed 15 selections.

Alternates: Not to exceed 3 selections, ranked in precedence order.

b. Physician Assistant: Commission upon completion of full-time training.

Primary Selects: Not to exceed 15 selections.

Alternates: Not to exceed 3 selections, ranked in precedence order.

c. Pharmacy: Commission upon completion of full-time training.

Primary Selects: Not to exceed 2 selections.

Alternates: Not to exceed 1 selection.

d. Environmental Health: Commission upon completion of full-time training.

Primary Selects: Not to exceed 1 selection.

Alternates: Not to exceed 1 selection.

e. Industrial Hygiene: Commission upon completion of full-time training.

Primary Selects: Not to exceed 1 selection.

Alternates: Not to exceed 1 selection.

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f. Radiation Health: Commission as fully qualified or upon completion of full-time training.

Primary Selects: Not to exceed 2 selections.
Alternates: Not to exceed 1 selection.

g. Occupational Therapy: Commission upon completion of full-time training.

Primary Selects: Not to exceed 2 selections.
Alternates: Not to exceed 1 selection.

h. Social Work (Master's Degree in Social Work (MSW) + Internship): Commission upon completion of MSW.


Primary Selects: Not to exceed 1 selection.
Alternates: Not to exceed 1 selection.

i. Social Work (Internship): For FY-15 commissioning, includes applicants with a completed qualifying degree and those who will complete a qualifying degree by June 2015.

Primary Selects: Not to exceed 1 selection.
Alternates: Not to exceed 1 selection.

2. The Board Sponsor will coordinate with the MSC Officer Community Manager (BUPERS-315) to ensure direct selects are added to a commissioning scroll immediately after official board notification and call-out with Chief of Naval Personnel.

3. All selectees must meet all qualifications for the program applied for as defined under reference (b) and the annual IPP NAVADMIN.
