

Definition of an Individual Family Service Plan (IFSP)

An IFSP is a plan that will identify what your child's current developmental levels are, what services will be provided to advance those levels, and what goals you would like to see your child reach. It will also contain valuable information about your child's strength, needs, likes, and dislikes.

The IFSP will include the following components:

- Information about family resources, priorities, and concerns
- Goals of the plan
- Detailed description of services required to reach the set goals
- Statement of the environment the services will be provided
- Start date, duration, and approximate re-evaluation date
- Name of the service coordinator
- Transition plan for your child

An IFSP is “intentionally” family focused.
