POSSIBLE LOSS OF PERSONALLY IDENTIFIABLE INFORMATION

Dear Sir/Madam:

This letter is to notify you of the potential compromise of your Personally Identifiable Information (PII). Specifically, the Pharmacy Department at Naval Hospital Pensacola reported a missing laptop computer on August 18, 2009, containing your name, sponsor's social security number, and date of birth.

While there is no evidence to suggest personal data has been compromised, it is Department of the Navy policy to apprise individuals who may have had personal data compromised.
