

How to Enroll Your Newborn In TRICARE Prime



Remember, your baby must be registered in the Defense Enrollment Eligibility Reporting System (DEERS)



If your family is currently enrolled in TRICARE Prime, your newborn will be automatically covered by TRICARE Prime for a period of up to 60 days. After the initial 60 days, any claim submitted for a newborn will process as a TRICARE Standard claim until the infant is registered in DEERS and enrolled in

TRICARE Prime.

You, the parent(s) must complete a new enrollment form for the newborn, with sponsor's information and your newborn's Primary Care Manager (PCM) choice. TRICARE also suggests to enroll your newborn at 2 weeks for well-baby check up.

Any additional fees will be due at that time, if applicable (does not apply to Active Duty families.)

You must make sure that your newborn is enrolled within 60 days from his or her date of birth. Contact TRICARE at 1-800-444-5445 for information on how to enroll, or go to the TRICARE Service Center office on the first floor at Naval Hospital Pensacola.
