Exceptional Family Member Program

The Exceptional Family Member Program (EFMP) is a servicewide program in keeping with the philosophy that the military takes care of its own. EFMP was established to assure that your child, or any family member, will have his or her special needs considered in the detailing process, and that the necessary medical and educational resources are made available to you. Examples of qualifying conditions are Attention Deficit Disorder, Asthma, Diabetes, or any chronic or acute problems that need extra care. If your family member qualifies, then please call our EFMP coordinator at 505-6183 for an enrollment interview.

You will be asked by the EFMP Coordinator if you need any special assistance for your family member. If so, Naval Hospital Pensacola will assign a Case Worker to assist you. You may also be assigned to a TRICARE Case Manager to assist in getting referrals, claims processed, etc.
