TRAVELING WITH YOUR TRICARE STANDARD COVERAGE

When you travel in the United States or overseas, TRICARE Standard goes with you. If you need emergency care, visit the nearest emergency room or call 911.

Traveling in the United States:

You will save money if you find seek care from a network TRICARE network provider. Your cost-share will be lower and the provider will file your claim. If the provider is non-network provider, you may have to pay upfront for the care and file a claim for reimbursement. For more information, visit: www.tricare.mil/travel



Traveling Overseas:

If you need emergency care, go to the nearest emergency care facility or call the Medical Assistance number for the overseas area where you are traveling. Contact the TRICARE Overseas Program (TOP) Regional Call Center for urgent care assistance. Always keep a copy of all your receipts. Overseas claims require proof of payment. Need Prescriptions When Traveling?

It is always recommended that you get your prescriptions filled before you travel, but if you need them filled while traveling, fill them at a military pharmacy if one is nearby.

You may fill the prescription at any TRICARE network pharmacy in while traveling in the United States or the U.S territories. If a network pharmacy is not available, visit a non-network pharmacy. For more information, visit: www.tricare.mil/pharmacy

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
