



**CMDCS (SW/AW) JAMES C. MAGEE
USNS COMFORT (T-AH 20) MEDICAL TREATMENT FACILITY
COMMAND MASTER CHIEF**

Senior Chief Magee is a native of Gulfport, Mississippi. He graduated from Harrison Central High School Class of 1994. He entered his Naval Service through the Delayed Entry program and completed basic training at Recruit Training Command in Great Lakes, IL in March 1995.

Following basic training, Senior Chief Magee reported to his first duty station, USS John F. Kennedy (CV-67), where he was advanced to Petty Officer Third Class and completed his first Mediterranean deployment.

In April of 1999, he reported to NAS Whiting Field and attended Aviation Boatswains Mate Handler “C” school in Pensacola, Fl. In July of 2002, he reported to the USS Harry S. Truman (CVN-75). While assigned to the TRUMAN he earned both his Enlisted Aviation/Surface Warfare pins and advanced to Petty Officer First Class. As the Hangar Bay Leading Petty Officer and completed two deployments.

In 2002, he reported to Naval Air Technical Training Center (NATTC) where he was selected to Chief Petty Officer as the Aircraft Firefighting Shipboard Team Trainer (AFSTT) Leading Chief Petty Officer. He reported to USS George H.W. Bush (CVN-77) in September of 2010 and advanced to Senior Chief Petty Officer and assumed the duties as the Hangar Bay / Flight Deck Leading Chief Petty Officer. During this tour he attended the Senior Enlisted Academy and completed two deployments.

In 2014, he reported to USS BATAAN as the Hangar Bay Leading Chief Petty Officer. He was then selected to the Command Senior Chief program. Senior Chief Magee is a graduate of the United States Navy Senior Enlisted Academy (class 178 purple), CMC/COB course (class 157). In May of 2016 he was selected as the Command Senior Chief onboard the USNS COMFORT (T-AH 20).

Senior Chief Magee holds an Associate’s Degree in Business Administration from Excelsior College. His personal awards include the Navy and Marine Corps Commendation Medal (three awards), Navy and Marine Corps Achievement Medal (four awards) and numerous other unit and campaign awards.
