Subj: DESIGNATION OF PRIVILEGING AUTHORITY AND ASSIGNMENT OF BUREAU

OF MEDICINE AND SURGERY RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1. <u>Purpose</u>. To provide information to Department of the Navy medical department personnel and leadership on the change in designation of privileging authority for Navy Reserve healthcare providers, and all other providers in billets not otherwise covered in the designation of privileging authorities under reference (a).
- 2. <u>Scope and Applicability</u>. This notice applies to all active duty and Reserve Navy and Marine Corps military and civilian medical personnel assigned to Navy operational units and Marine operational forces.
- 3. <u>Background</u>. Per reference (b), the designated privileging authority for Navy Reserve healthcare providers changed from Deputy Chief, Bureau of Medicine and Surgery (BUMED-N3) to Chief Medical Officer (BUMED-N01CMO). As a result of reorganization and changes to title positions at BUMED, this designation must be updated to reflect the current title for this authority.
- 4. <u>Action</u>. BUMED-N01CMO is the designated privileging authority for Navy Reserve healthcare providers and all other providers in billets not otherwise covered in the designation of privileging authorities under reference (a). With this designation, BUMED-N10 assumes the roles and responsibilities for Navy Medicine's Credentialing and Privileging program as defined in reference (a). Reference (c) is specific to Reserve Component providers and provides guidance for BUMED-N01CMO in performance of privileging duties.

5. Records Management

a. Records created as a result of this notice, regardless of format or media, must be maintained and dispositioned per the records disposition schedules located on the Department of the Navy Directorate for Administration, Logistics, and Operations, Directives and Records Management Division portal page at https://portal.secnav.navy.mil/orgs/DUSNM/DONAA/DRM/Records-and-Information-Management/Approved%20Record%20Schedules/Forms/AllItems.aspx.
