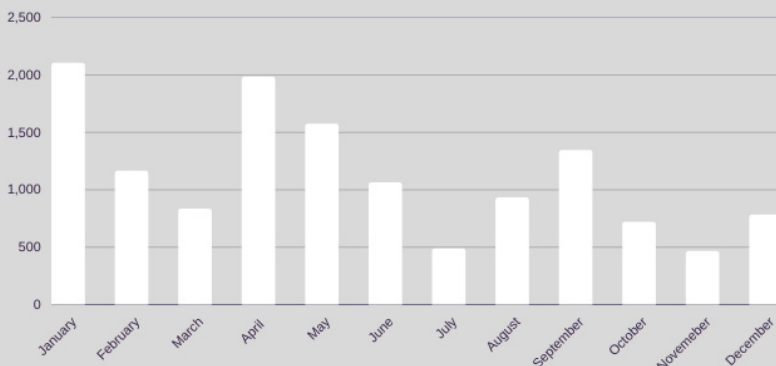

Media Exposure: Total mentions from all sources trended over time.

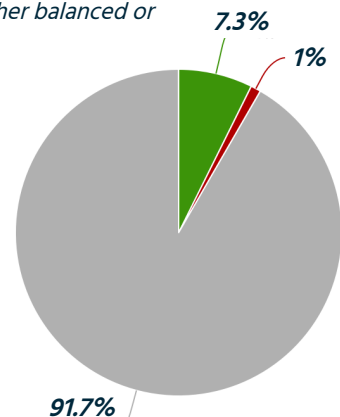
- 13,500+ news articles mentioned "Navy Medicine" in 2021. Approximately 37 news articles a day.

 Balanced



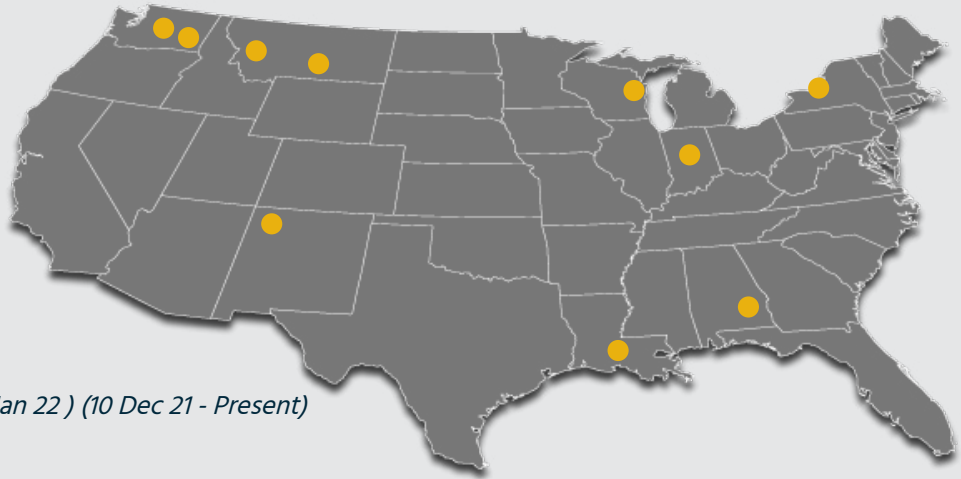

PLATFORMS: MEDICAL RESPONSE TEAMS (MRTs)

Mission: 23-person team comprised of physicians, nurses and respiratory therapy technicians who provide support to COVID-19 relief missions at civilian hospitals.

Vaccine Distribution

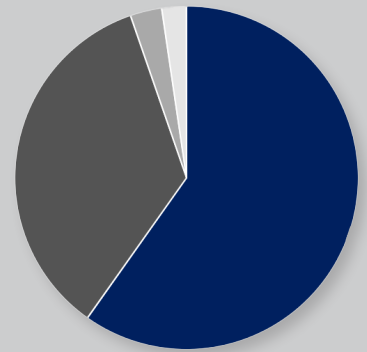
Naval Medical Logistics Command (NMLC)

keeps "Med Gear at the Tip of the Spear" with support of **190** people including: Medical Service Corps Officers, Supply Corps Officers, Sailors, Analysts, Contracting Specialists, Clinical Engineers, Biomedical Equipment Technicians, Support Staff and Contractors.

- In 2021, NMLC delivered **95+%** of the **Flu** vaccine to the Department of the Navy.

NMLC COVID-19 vaccine delivery as of Dec 2021:

- Adult Pfizer: **975,213** doses
- Moderna: **569,098** doses
- Janssen: **48,160** doses
- Ped Pfizer: **37,780** doses



Optical Fabrication Services

Naval Ophthalmic Support and Training Activity (NOSTRA) enables vision readiness and eye protection of our Armed Forces through the delivery of quality eyewear devices worldwide. It is the Department of Defense (DoD) Program Executive Office for all military optical fabrication.

Fabrication:

- The Navy Optical Fabrication Enterprise achieves a **3.3** day priority cycle time for optical devices with **99%** being out the door within 7 days.
- In 2021, NOSTRA averaged **2,200** new requests daily for optical devices.
- NOSTRA's is the **largest** Optical Fabrication Enterprise (OFE) laboratory in the U.S. military.

Pier-side Service:

- In 2021, conducted Optical Assist Visit (OAV) onboard **14** platforms providing Eye-Wear ordering and fitting services for Sailors in the Hampton Roads area.
- In response to COVID restrictions placed throughout the United States, service members were provided access to "G-Eyes" an online platform that allows Soldiers, Sailors, Airmen and Marines to reorder prescription glasses, gas mask inserts and Military Combat Eye Protection (MCEP) directly from the internet without the need to go to the clinic.
