A native of Tucson, Arizona, Mr. Brito served 20.9 years active duty as a 8404 Hospital Corpsman/Biomedical Equipment Technician (BMET) in the United States Navy. His most notable assignments include his role as FMF Hospital Corpsman with 1st Battalion 7TH Marines, deployed with Charlie "Suicide" Company (Operation Desert Storm, first Gulf War) and being deployed as the BIOMED, Leading Petty Officer onboard the USNS Comfort (T-AH 20) notably deployed during the Second Gulf War. He also merged two (Army and Navy) Medical Maintenance programs to one program during is time at NNMCM/WRNMMC Bethesda.

Mr. Brito has continued to serve he has 18 years in the GS community. He has held Supervisory and Non-Supervisory positions with Navy and DHA. He was appointed by LTG (Ret) Ronald J. Place as the DHA Component Property Lead managing DHA's a Personal Property Book with a value over \$7B. He was the Med Maintenance Supervisor at NNMCM and resumed the role as the Chief, Med Maintenance when NNMCM and WRAMC realigned to become the WRNMMC (under the 2005 BRAC).

Mr. Brito has held a couple of positions at Fort Detrick at NMRLC/NMRLC-DET with BIOMED Operations, Property Management Office, the OFSD Life Cycle Product Support Supervisor.
